Report of the NASGBI ASM 2015, Manchester

- The 50thAnnual Scientific Meeting 2015 of the Neuroanaesthesia Society of Great Britain and Ireland was held at Hotel Hilton, Manchester, United Kingdom on 07th and 08th may 2015. The conference was organized by the Department of Anaesthetics, Royal Hallamshire Hospital, Glossop Road, Sheffield Teaching Hospitals under able leadership of Dr Craig Caroll. The theme was based on the society's objective of "the advancement of education for the public benefit in the science of neuroanaesthesia and neurocritical care". Also the society was rechristened as The Neuroanaesthesia & Critical Care Society of Great Britain and Ireland (NACCS) from NASGBI.
- Over a hundred delegates participated; out of which **ISNACC members**, Dr Mihir Prakash Pandia, Dr Hemanshu Prabhakar, Dr Girija Rath, Dr Bhavna Hooda and Dr Sujoy Banik from AIIMS, New Delhi and Dr Harsh Sapra from Medanta Hospital, Gurgaon, attended the conference.
- The event commenced with an Introductory and welcome speech by Dr Craig Caroll, organizing chairperson and Dr Ian Tweedie, NASGBI immediate past president.
- First scientific session began with Issues pertaining to Safety in Neuro environment; how similar it is to managing the aerodrome and how tedious can long working hours be in Neuro theatres. This was followed by heated debate on pros and cons of having Specialist Neuro intensive care units.
- During the lunch break, there were breakout sessions on how to work in partnership with legal advice clinics, Optimizing cerebral blood flow in Subarachnoid haemorrhage and Neuroradiology for the neuroanaesthetist/ neurointensivist. In addition, there were common simulated adult and paediatric neuro scenarios organized for the benefit of trainees in separate meeting rooms.
- Post lunch session dealt with the "Known knowns and Known unknowns of Delayed neurological deficit and Big hitters in neuroanaesthesia / neurocritical care.
- Day one concluded with President's reception at Cloud 23 lounge; one of the highest buildings with unparallel view of the city of Manchester. This was followed by a musical evening and Gala dinner at the Deansgate Suite, Hilton.
- Day 2 of the meeting began with exuberant talk by paediatric neurosurgeon on paediatric tumour surgery followed by discussion on rescuing the injured brain by Professor Peter Hutchinson, Prof (neurosurgery) from Cambridge University.
- Pre lunch session commenced with free paper presentations and poster presentations chaired by Dr Matt Wiles, Research lead of NASGBI council. Post lunch deliberation was by Dame Professor Nancy Rothwell, Vice Chancellor of University of Manchester on Inflammation and Brain Injury: Discovery and treatment.
- The meeting concluded with the valedictory function and prize distribution for the Best Oral paper and Poster presentation respectively. **Dr Bhavna Hooda** was awarded best poster presentation for her research paper titled "Effect of Tranexamic Acid on Intra-operative Blood Loss and Transfusion Requirements in Patients Undergoing Excision of Intracranial Meningioma."
- The delegates came forward to share their experiences and suggestions and congratulated the organisers for the academic feast. The organising secretary, on behalf of his team thanked everyone for their active participation during the conference and made official announcement of ASM 2016 at Southampton, UK.

Travel/Visit Grant

ISNACC provides Travel/ Visit Grant to suitable candidates to either visit one of the premier Neurosciences (Neuroanaesthesiology) Centers abroad or to present scientific paper(s) in an International forum. A fixed sum of Rs.25,000/- will be awarded to candidates who must fulfill the following criteria –

- 1. Should be a life-member for more than a year at the time of application.
- 2. He/she should not have availed the grant from ISNACC in previous 2 years.

Research Grant

ISNACC awards research grant to suitable candidates to carry out clinical research in the field of Neuroanaesthesia and Neurocritical Care in India. A fixed sum of Rs.50,000/- [2 candidates per year] will be awarded to candidates who fulfill the following criteria –

1. Should be a life-member for more than a year at the time of application.

2. He/she should not have availed the grant from ISNACC in previous 2 years

3. Should provide a copy of Ethics Committee approval

4. Financial assistance from other sources must be disclosed

5. Should present the results of the research in the Annual conference of ISNACC in the same year as completion of study.

6. Should acknowledge ISNACC as the funding source if the paper is sent for publication in a journal.
